A quantity of copper wire was stolen from the roadside and residents are asked to report any suspect activity to the police.• Highways – County Council will be contacted for update on schedule.• World horse charging for access – Cllr Skinner will check the legal position.• SAM2 – Cllr Skinner is looking into this and will report. |

| 07/22 | A precept rise of 3% was proposed by Cllr Goldsmith and seconded by Cllr Romero. This was unanimously agreed. |
